Attention Exhibitors

The Kent Building is a large (~ 40,000 sq. ft.) open sided pavilion. While considered open sided, metal paneling extends down about half way from the ceiling on all sides and shade cloths are on the east and west side. The floor is level matted concrete and there is good lighting. Six rings (from ~ 40' X 55' to 40' X 50' (Toys)) will be set up in the Kent Building.

Grooming space will be available around the perimeter of the building.

Electric will be available, but will need to be shared. Please bring extension cords and power bars. **Given the open sided nature of the building,** it may be a good idea to bring tarps to cover your set-up when you are not there.

This year all RV reservations will be made through the DelMarvelous Cluster.

Fairgrounds will open for RV parking on Thursday, September 18, 2025 at 10:00 AM.

Exhibitor set-up in the Kent Building will start at 12:00 noon.

Grounds will be open to exhibitors at 6:00 AM each morning of the show.

Food will be available.

No smoking in any building.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crate except when being judged or when in an x-pen.

Dogs cannot be left in the show building overnight.

No strollers of any kind allowed.

No private golf carts allowed (fairground rules).







Delaware State Fairgrounds New Camping Guide

- This year all RV reservations in the Grove will be handled by the DelMarvelous Cluster. All sites have water and either 30 or 50 amp electric hook-ups (50 amp limited/first come, first served). Two dump sites are available on the grounds and restrooms and shower facilities are close. Reservations will cost \$50.00 per night. For those who arrive without reservations, the cost will be \$60.00 per night. Please note that there is no Handicapped Parking for RVs.

Recreational Vehicle (RV) Parking Information:

Failure to follow the rules or directions of the officials on duty will cause the immediate forfeiture of all parking privileges without refund of fees that have been paid. Routes to the Show

From Wilmington/Philadelphia: Take I-95 South toward Baltimore. Merge onto DE-1 South via Exit #4A toward Christina. Exit #97 to 13 Salisbury/Norfolk. Bear left onto US Route 13 South; follow South toward Harrington. After passing over DE-14, look for Fairgrounds on your right.

From Baltimore/Washington DC: Take US-50 East, US 301 North. At US-50/US-301 split, bear right, taking US-50 East. Turn left onto US-404 East toward Denton/Rehoboth. Take the MD-313 ramp toward Denton/Greensboro. Turn left onto MD-313 North. Turn right onto MD-317 East. As you cross into DE, MD-317 becomes DE-14. Follow DE-14 East through Harrington. At junction with US Route 13 South, turn right. Look for Fairgrounds on your right.

Enter through the Main Gate. Turn right at the first asphalt road and proceed to the Kent Building (second building after Quillen Arena).

Parking

Parking at sides and south end of the Kent Building for unloading only (lights on). Once unloaded, move vehicle to parking areas.



All credit card entries, regardless of method submitted, are processed through the Fax program and are charged the \$4.95 administrative fee. This Fax Fee is subject to change without notice.
- Make All Checks and Money Orders payable to MB-F, Inc. CANADIAN/FOREIGN exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS. When you provide a check as payment, you authorize us to either use information from your check to make a one-time electronic fund transfer from your account or to process the payment as a check. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Superintendent assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. Tabulate carefully. Due to cost of processing, no refunds \$5.00 and under will be made.
- Post Dated Checks, Returned Checks and Declined Credit Cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check or declined card. Subsequent returned checks or declined cards from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- CHARGEBACKS on Credit Cards are considered a violation of your agreement to pay the required entry fee for entry into a show and the AKC Compliance Dept. will be notified for their disciplinary action. Also, if this remains a bad debt, the club may decline future entries for their shows and the superintendent will decline future entries for ANY show submitted via any method of payment until the debt is paid (Chap. 11, Sec. 15, AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows). Thereafter, the superintendent will refuse all future credit card entries from the exhibitor. All future entries must be paid for in cash or by money order or check.
- An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 first entry only and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 for first entry and \$3.50 for each additional entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 will be required for each first entry and \$3.50 for each additional entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. An AKC Event Service Fee of \$2.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Open Show. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions.)

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

- Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the event, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline (877) 252-3229.
- No Refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. An Administrative Fee of \$5.00 will be charged or withheld from refunds for duplicate entries.
- An Administrative Fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.
- Each Owner and Agent listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at a show is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed & submitted the entry form.
- As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.
- Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
- Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.
- All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.
- Class Cash Prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Superintendent's Office advised at once. The Superintendents and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.
- No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

HOW TO USE THE ENTRY BLANK

Use one entry blank per dog only if information is exactly the SAME for each event. Carefully check the block (blocks) for each event in which you wish to enter your dog. You MUST use a SEPARATE entry blank, if you are entering your dog in a different class on different events.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- 5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
